appoint a suitable person to serve until the next general election for State and County officers.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

## CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 3 and 8 of Chapter 731 of the Acts of 1920 and to add sixteen additional sections to be numbered and designated as Sections 10A, 10B, 10C, 10D, 10E, 10F, 10G, 10H, 10 I, 10J, 10K, 10L, 10M, 10N, 10 O and 10P, to said Act of 1920, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Riverdale, in Prince George's County, Maryland, and to fix the town limits thereof, define the persons qualified to vote therein, to provide for and regulate the election and appointment of officers therefor and the terms and qualifications of such officers, to define the method of government thereof, to define the corporate powers and to provide an election to determine whether or not the citizens thereof desire to become incorporated.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 3 and 8 of Chapter 731 of the Acts of 1920, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Riverdale in Prince George's County, Maryland, and to fix the town limits thereof, define the persons qualified to vote therein, to provide for and regulate the election and appointment of officers therefor and the terms and qualifications of such officers, to define the method of Government thereof, to define the corporate powers and to provide an election to determine whether or not the citizens thereof desire to become incorporated, be and the same hereby are repealed and re-enacted with amendments and that there be added sixteen additional sections to be numbered and designated as Sections 10A, 10B, 10C, 10D, 10E, 10E, 10G, 10H, 10I, 10J, 10K, 10L, 10M, 10N, 10 0 and 10P to read as follows:
