SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1933.

CHAPTER 209.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Further Regulations in County Waters," said new section to be known as Section 32A and to follow immediately after Section 32 of said Article, relating to the taking of eels, terrapin and turtles in the waters of Charles and St. Mary's Counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Further Regulations in County Waters," said new section to be known as Section 32A, to follow immediately after Section 32 of said Article and to read as follows:

32A. No person except bona fide residents of Charles and St. Mary's Counties shall, in any of the waters thereof except the Patuxent river, take or catch eels, terrapin and turtles, with a seine, gill net, pound net, trap net, fyke net, eel pot, or any kind of net or device whatever for taking eels, terrapin and turtles, except hook and line. Any person violating any of the provisions hereof shall, upon conviction, be fined One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or sentenced to the House of Correction for not less than three months nor more than one year, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.
