Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to The Home for the Aged of the Methodist Episcopal Church, of Baltimore City.

Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to the Kelso Home for Orphans, of Baltimore City.

CHAPTER 239.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 72 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Oysters," sub-title "Potomac," said new section to be known as Section 75B and to follow immediately after Section 75A of said Article, providing for the establishment of a line on the Maryland side of the Potomac River and prohibiting the taking or catching of oysters, crabs and fish on the north side of said line except by residents of Maryland.
