your return receipt to this letter, or else judgment by de-
fault may be entered against you.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall
take effect June 1, 1933.

CHAPTER 289.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section
233 of Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws of
Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Chancery," sub-title
"Sales," so as to confer upon executors, administrators
or other personal representatives of a decedent the right
to file a creditor's bill for the sale of the real estate of a
decedent in cases where the personal estate of such de-
cedent is insufficient to pay the debts of the estate and
costs of administration.
