

right of way which they may find necessary for conduits for said water to enter in and distribute through said town, or beyond the corporate limits of said town, or if such owner is under any disability or incapacity to contract, or absent or unknown, the said Water Board is hereby clothed with power of condemnation under the right of eminent domain, as now provided by the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland as fully as if said provisions had been herein incorporated. The said Water Board shall make rules and regulations for the construction, erection, management and maintenance of said water works and water distribution system and shall establish rates for water service, and may, with the approval of the Burgess and Commissioners, establish the same rates or different rates for water service and for water supplied to persons and corporations beyond the corporate limits, and shall make semi-annual reports of their proceedings and of the condition of said water works and water distribution system to the Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport; they shall have power to enter into contracts for building said water works and water distribution system, to contract for material therefor, to employ all necessary labor and clerks, and to fix their compensation, and the four persons appointed to said Water Board shall be appointed for the term of one, two, three and four years, respectively, as to the first appointees, and their successors shall be appointed for the term of four years. Any member of the Water Board shall be eligible for reappointment, and the Burgess of said town for the time being shall always be ex-officio a member of said Water Board.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

AN ACT to repeal Section 120 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County," sub-title "County Treasurer," and to enact in lieu thereof fifteen new sections to be known as
