

tion. The Town Clerk shall preside at said meeting; a secretary shall be chosen who is a legal voter in the town and he shall keep a record of the proceedings of said meeting and file the same in the office of the Town Clerk.

Candidates for Mayor shall be not less than thirty years of age and candidates for Councilmen not less than twenty-five years of age; they shall have resided in the town at least one year immediately preceding their nomination and be legal voters and property holders therein. Nominations of candidates for Mayor and Councilmen shall be made on motion of any citizen who is a qualified voter in the town and if such nomination is seconded by at least two additional qualified voters, and not otherwise, the person so nominated shall be considered a candidate and his name shall be placed upon the official ballot.

It shall be unlawful and shall be deemed a corrupt practice for any person, association, organization, committee or corporation to publish or distribute or cause to be published or distributed any pamphlet, circular, card, dodger, poster, advertisement or any printed, multigraphed, photographed, typewritten or written matter or statement or any matter or statement which may be copied by any device or method now known for printing or copying or which may hereafter be used for making copies of printed or written matter in any form whatever for publication or distribution, relating to or concerning any candidate or prospective candidate for Mayor of the Town of Takoma Park or Councilman of the said town, unless such pamphlet, circular, card, dodger, poster, advertisement or other form of publication herein described contains the name or names of the person or persons, association, committee or corporation responsible for the publication or distribution of the same, and if an association, committee or corporation is responsible for the publication or distribution of the same, there shall be attached the names of the officers of such association, committee or corporation. Any person violating any provision of this paragraph, or aiding and abetting the violation thereof, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or be imprisoned for not more than one year, or both fined and imprisoned. And this paragraph shall be enforced by warrant or indictment before the circuit court of the county in which the offense occurs, and the provisions of Section 967 of Article 16 and the provisions of Section 960 of Article 17 shall not apply to the enforcement of this paragraph.
