

feet, thence north  $22^{\circ} 51' 50''$  west 654.19 feet to a concrete monument number 11109, thence north  $52^{\circ} 35' 30''$  west 306.39 feet to a concrete monument number 11110, thence still with the approximate center line of said road north  $36^{\circ} 10' 30''$  west 359.43 feet, thence north  $12^{\circ} 50' 20''$  west 544.97 feet to a concrete monument number 11112, thence north  $18^{\circ} 53' 40''$  west 234.67 feet to a concrete monument number 11113, thence still with the approximate center line of said road north  $0^{\circ} 37' 50''$  west 202.61 feet, north  $31^{\circ} 52' 30''$  west 600.21 feet, north  $24^{\circ} 47'$  west 252.31 feet to a concrete monument number 11118, thence leaving said road and running north  $61^{\circ} 24' 00''$  east 236.41 feet to a concrete monument number 11119, thence following the center line of Weems Creek easterly for a distance of approximately 5800 feet to the center of the draw of the state highway bridge crossing Weems Creek at Revell Street, thence still with the center line of Weems Creek in a general northeasterly direction approximately 3600 feet to the mouth of said Weems Creek; thence still northeasterly and with the waters of Severn River approximately 1300 feet to a point distant north 31,400 feet, east 24,000 feet from the aforementioned origin of co-ordinates, thence with the waters of the Severn River southeasterly approximately 15,000 feet to a point distant north 19,500 feet east 33,000 feet from the aforementioned origin of co-ordinates, then still with the waters of Severn River south  $71^{\circ} 28' 40''$  west 2700.9 feet to the concrete monument at the place of beginning, containing 5.57 square miles of land, more or less. Bearings are referred to the true meridian at the origin of co-ordinates.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of said act, the said sewerage district shall be under the jurisdiction of a commission of five members, namely:
