

ever so requested by any of the Commissioners. In all court proceedings under or pursuant to this Article, the decision of the Commission shall be prima facie correct and the burden of proof shall be upon the party attacking the same.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1933.

CHAPTER 511.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 190 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Licenses," sub-title "Motor Vehicles," sub-heading "Non-Resident Owners and Operators," eliminating the provision as to non-residents operating motor vehicles for hire over fixed routes or between termini.
