MR. MELVIN: I think so, too. I think these are very valuable to the Commission at this point. I am

not prepared to answer them right now.

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think anybody is really prepared to answer them right now and that again is reflected in the research questions that we have asked for and the value of that information once it is obtained, because it is going to be a matter of aiding. I think the help that we've gotten insofar as Mr. Ratchford and Mr. Thompson is concerned helps us along the line of eventually making these decisions which eventually we are going to have to make. However, again, I do feel, Ridge, it is important to us to keep the thinking of the Commission as a whole, the tenor of the thinking of the Commission, if for no other reason, that we get on stage for a little while and get the reasons from somebody here,

There are other valuable members on the Committee, such as Mr. Thayer. His thinking and reaction to a lot of these questions would be important. He really to some extent is an expert in this field of local
