to get this type of legislation through, and I have already 1 seen in just this first week a number of bills that have 2 been introduced from small counties, basically enlarging 3 the powers of the Board of County Commissioners. 4 pect we will see toward the end of this session the 5 creation of positions of administrative assistants or 6 some type of professional administration direction in the 7 counties. This would be another factor. 8 Of course, there would be no way really to 9 know what has been enacted until about the end of March, 10 but obviously any analysis which you make I think should 11 include this, because I feel this session, more than most 12 legislative sessions, will bring about some changes in 13 many of the existing county governments. However, as I 14 say, this will be toward the end of March before this 15 type of thing will be available; and I would be very. 16 happy, because part of my job is to keep track of this 17 type of legislation, to feed the information into your 18 Committee, so you could have it and you will see the 19 20 changes as they develop in these counties.
