MR. RATCHFORD: No, not so much the Code

County, but more in line with -- there is a provision of the law, Article 25, which is the general County Commissioners law in the State of Maryland. One of the sections, Section 3, has, I believe, twenty-five enumerated powers that a County Board can exercise. Many of the counties

are exempted from this. They are beginning to take off

some of these exemptions; that is one phase.

I think it will be done not so much in reference to the Code or home rule, but in what they can do by local legislation this year which perhaps, next time around, they will not have a senator and they would rather

get it done now. As I said, this will be done through local law, but they will make some changes in perhaps the type of analysis Miss Spencer and Mr. Nash made in their studies, that I feel sure you would want to take into account in your own analysis.
