

1 office or the Director of the Budget, the Director of
2 the Budget, I believe asked for an audit of their calculations. This was readily granted. The first year they went
3 through, found no change and could make none, the second
4 year they gave it up halfway through, so that I think this
5 is perfectly proper. To summarize, then, I would, number
6 one, agree with you that I would hope the Commission, this
7 Committee, would leave this section of the Constitution
8 exactly as is. If the Committee feels, as I gather at
9 least Mr. Case felt so the other day, there is some need
10 for review, then we would suggest it be of this order, and
11 I think this should clear up any problems.

13 DR. JENKINS: You see the great protection here
14 with the President as I understand it, is that although
15 the governor and the Budget Bureau raise a question about
16 the figures, unless the State Department of Education
17 agrees, he may not change these figures. He might bring pres-
18 sure otherwise, but that is up to the intestinal fortitude
19 of the Superintendent. He still has the constitutional
20 protection.

21 The third question I want to ask is really not
