The constitutional provision that we are looking at says, and I am quoting again, "and for the public schools," and I repeat, "and for the public schools." Now --

DR. SENSENBAUGH: Which reference is that?

MR. CASE: Subsection 11, of Section 52,

and I am wondering whether or not language couldn't

be suggested which would more adequately and properly

describe really what is going on here?

DR. SENSENBAUGH: You could say and for purposes of State support to local school systems, if this is what it is trying to say.

MR. CASE: The words and for the public schools certainly don't really describe, at least in my mind, what the procedure is. It is for the schools, but it is not that vague, really. Actually --

DR. SENSENBAUGH: It is for the State Aid
Program that goes out to local school systems. This
is what we are really talking about. Now, sure, there
are other things probably before the schools that -I don't know right offhand what they might be, but --
