DR. JENKINS: I'm not quite clear on this 1 point, Dr. Sensenbaugh. Is it your fear that after the 2 appropriation is made, someone, either the Governor, 3 the Budget Bureau or the State Superintendent of Schools, may divert the appropriation to other purposes 5 DR. SENSENBAUGH: There may be times when 6 funds that should be dedicated to educational purposes DR. JENKINS: This fund we're talking about, the aid? 9 DR. SENSENBAUGH: It may not necessarily be 10 the aid. It may be something else, some other kind of 11 educational fund that can be established. Any time you 12 get a fund built up and dedicated to education, or I 13 suppose any fund dedicated to any other purpose, and 14 if it is in the bank, it might be a benefit program to 15 certain people, you see, this type of thing, and some-16 times, if there are funds in the treasury, even though 17 they are dedicated funds, states, government departments 18 have been known to tap those funds. 19 DR. JENKINS: Are there such educational 20 funds now? 21
