1 amount so that we wouldn't know -- and after the budget 2 came out, if our half million dollars for handicapped 3 children aid, for example, were reduced in order to balance the budget or because somebody was unsympathetic 5 to taking care of severely handicapped children or 6 something else, and that were reduced, we could not 7 count in Baltimore County on getting aid for those 8 pupils that we count on, which is only a small part of 9 the total cost of the program, but it is that much 10 contribution. 11 We would have to curtail our program. 12 would have to, I think, not give broad aid to them. 13 could happen. There is no question about it. 14 MR. CASE: Am I correct in saying that State 15 aid for the physically and mentally handicapped children 16 is a part of this basic program, such as driver educa-17 tion, public community colleges and adult education?

DR. SENSENBAUGH: That is spelled out by law, the aid to handicapped children. That is \$600 per school.

All of that comes into it?
