

1 MR. CASE: Right.

2 DR. SENSENBAUGH: Now, that is not part of
3 that calculation of the lump sum.

4 MR. WILLIAM PERKINS: It is in another part
5 of the law.

6 DR. SENSENBAUGH: It is basic aid. It is
7 aid.

8 MR. CASE: It is basic aid.

9 DR. SENSENBAUGH: But it is not this formula
10 here, which is the main bulk of it.

11 MR. CASE: These are under other State aids,
12 other than the basic program?

13 DR. SENSENBAUGH: Yes, but they are State
14 aid programs.

15 MR. CASE: And these have been ruled by the
16 Attorney General as being subject to the constitutional
17 provision we talked about this morning; is that right?

18 DR. SENSENBAUGH: I don't know whether the
19 Attorney General's office has ruled on it, but we have
20 been following that practice.

21 MR. CASE: In other words, as far as the
