2 that the State supports of that figure? It isn't a
3 matter of --

4 MR. CASE: We've got the formula and we've
5 got your book and I guess I can explain it as good as
6 Dr. Sensenbaugh did at the last meeting. That is going
7 to satisfy me.

8 DR. EARHART: It is essentially, the State
9 supports essentially 40 per cent of the 340. So long
10 as that is fixed.

11 DR. SENSENBAUGH: That is not uniform, you
12 know that. It depends upon the wealth of the local --

13 MR. CASE: I don't know how the 1.228 figure
14 ever came out of the ground, but that is not part of
15 this Committee's inquiry.

16 DR. SENSENBAUGH: I think it was to balance
17 the formula.

18 MR. CASE: I would like to know how that
19 figure was struck some day.

20 MR. ENEY: I would like to follow that same
21 thing, to see if this sentence about the sacred nature
