such a thing as a school fund derived from special 1 taxation or from endowments of various sorts, and our 2 investigation indicates that Maryland has none of any 3 consequence and that this Section 3 is referring to some anachronism. 5 We recommended that it be eliminated for 6 that reason and not because we wanted to see the 7 appropriations for use of the schools violated and --B MR. BROOKS: Mr. Chairman, I believe Mr. 9 Perkins has said on prior occasions that under the 10 Maryland system there are no funds, educational or 11 otherwise, and this provision would not protect any 12 funds because there is only a general fund and, even 13 though amounts are appropriated to agencies, this act 14 of the legislature creates no funds in the State but 15 the current system and therefore --16 MR. CASE: It may not create any fund, as 17 such, but I think you would have a pretty good shot 18 at a test case in saying that the legislature could not 19

tions into other departments of State government, so
