9 Elsbeth. All you have to do is ask them.

10 MRS. BOTHE: I would like to know.

11 MR. BROOKS: Dr. Zimmerman said, and I quote:
12 "It reverts. That is what I was talking about. It
13 goes back," to the general fund, and I think this
14 ought to be reflected in the record.

15 MR. PERKINS: The money is appropriated.
16 It may not go to the treasury, but it is earmarked to
17 an account number in the State Department of Education.
18 When we say revert, then that money comes out of that
19 account and goes into another account.

20 MR. CASE: But it has never left the treasurer.

21 MR. PERKINS: That's right.
