fact. 1 MR. CASE: They never asked for a ruling 2 because they never had to. 3 MR. ENEY: That may be, but the fact is they never considered it as such, whatever effect it might 5 have. 6 MR. CASE: That doesn't have too much effect 7 to me because what these gentlemen are saying is that 8 they think there ought -- don't let me put words in 9 your mouth, but Dr. Sensenbaugh, let me ask you this. 10 Do you think the Constitution ought to contain a pro-11 vision which would prevent the legislature from switch-12 ing funds out of the education and into other areas, 13 assuming a reversion was going to take place? 14 DR. SENSENBAUGH: I'm not so sure it wouldn't 15 be a good protection for all departments, that you 16 couldn't have this interplay, because I could conceive 17 that somebody wants to build up an area somewhere and 18 they go in and they tap other departments in order to 19 make --20 MR. HOFF: There's a lot of room for 21
