which was called the school fund. That is reflected 1 in our statutory provisions, but under modern budgets, 2 there is a general fund for which appropriations are 3 made and there are not two tax rates and there is not a general fund and a school fund working in conjunction. 5 6 They are still all one general fund. So, the use of the words school fund is now 7 an anachronism. 8 That was our statement. 9 MRS. BOTHE: 10 MR. PERKINS: That was my statement, and if 11 you want to retain this, it has to be revised. DR. SENSENBAUGH: I think the intent is 12 good. 13 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Mr. Chairman, if you say 14 all other departments are protected by statute, then 15 why couldn't the school be protected? If you can't 16 take reversions and play hanky-panky with them for all 17 departments, why --18 MR. CASE: That is the question, Mrs. 19 Freedlander, I don't know. Maybe they ought to take --20 21 as Mrs. Bothe's committee suggested, scrap this whole THE JACK SALOMON REFORTING SERVICE
