They elect their boards. They have the taxing authority. 1 They levy their own taxes for the support of their 2 I don't know of any state that does this, at the state level. MR. ENEY: Well, this was quite common some 5 vears back, was it not? 6 DR. SENSENBAUGH: Yes, and it is still quite 7 prevalent in some areas. I think there is a tendency 8 to have elected board members in the smaller school 9 districts, where people know each other more so than 10 they do over a large area. 11 If you look at your big cities, and I have 12 a feeling, now, this is just an impression, that most 13 of the big cities do not elect their board members; 14 although, this is not true in Boston. I know Boston 15 does elect their board members. 16 MR. ENEY: Dr. Sensenbaugh, I would like to 17 ask you this, and it comes back to what you were saying 18 before, but I would like to get a little more specific, 19 by statute, now, not by the Constitution. 20 The Governor appoints the members of the 21
