done on the local level. Principals are appointed on 1 the local level. The State Superintendent has nothing 2 to do with the principals in the twenty-four subdivi-3 sions. Ą MR. HOFF: This can shift down. 5 DR. SENSENBAUGH: Principals do move about 6 from one system to another and you have a staff of 7 supervisors at the central office and we have quite a 8 sizable group of them and --9 MR. ENEY: Are they merit system employees? 10 DR. SENSENBAUGH: No, they are not merit 11 system employees, but they are subject to approval --12 the Superintendent recommends them and they receive 13 approval from the Board of Education. 14 MR. BOTHE: Of course, if there is no 15 thought of putting any of this in the Constitution, it 16 is outside of our purview and concern. 17 MR.
