SENSENBAUGH: Once you are one of his 2 staff members, you owe a support to him, although you 3 would certainly want to feel free to point out changes, 4 if you think they were wholesome and good and I think a 5 Governor would want that. 6 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Yes, but that is not 7 usually the path you take. I am talking about your 8 staff doesn't take that path usually. Your staff goes 9 to the legislature. For instance, if Mr. Sartorius 10 were here, he would go to the Baltimore delegation of 11 the legislature, and this is what he does when --12 If he wants local legis-DR. SENSENBAUGH: 13 lation for his schools. 14 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Even if he wants it for 15 the State Board, he goes to the Baltimore delegation. 16
