

1 appropriations they may use to pay higher salaries,
2 which are nevertheless appropriations which the legis-
3 lature can give or withhold. So that the autonomy was
4 not independent of the legislature, to some extent, as
5 the executive.

6 MR. PERKINS: But there is \$40,000,000 in
7 the budget of the University that we don't even see.

8 MRS. BOTHE: That being --

9 MR. PERKINS: They are restricted and dedi-
10 cated funds, but plus the fact that in the amounts they
11 do receive, there are certain things we have no control
12 over, the Governor or the Budget Bureau.

13 MRS. BOTHE: You are speaking now of what
14 areas of income?

15 MR. PERKINS: There are all kinds, research
16 grants, endowment funds and other areas.

17 MRS. BOTHE: Are these from sources other
18 than taxpayers?

19 MR. PERKINS: Yes.

20 MR. ENEY: Tuition doesn't go into the
21 budget.
