it works. 1 MR. ENEY: You mean in practice? 2 MR. PERKINS: I'm in education and I don't 3 have anything to do with the judiciary, MRS. BOTHE: You say that the President of 5 the University at the time the autonomy act went into 6 effect no longer thinks well of it? 7 MR. PERKINS: I heard the statement made that 8 Curley Byrd, and he's the one that got the autonomy 9 for the University, as I understand it, said it was a 10 11 mistake. Maybe it's because he was out, I don't know, 12 but he said it was a mistake that they got it. Maybe it's a reflection. Maybe, after reflection, he changed 13 his mind. 14 MRS. BOTHE: He figured he did better than 15 going to the legislature for a gymnasium. Does anyone 16 else have any questions? 17 DR. SENSENBAUGH: There is one comment I 18 wanted to make. You have, on Page 8, in the Committee 19 report, reference to children of school age. Now, the 20 statutory provisions change from time to time. We are 21

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
