the reasons we left it that way was because Section 1 does deal with the elementary school system and deals with minors, and some state constitutions give specific aid, say up to the age of eighteen, and we didn't want to do that in the expectation that perhaps the compulsory age would be upgraded and someday we expect there will be a kindergarten throughout the State. Have you any suggestions?

DR. SENSENBAUGH: I think that Mr. Eney had
