There is, of course, information in Miss 1 Spencer's book which has already been referred to with 2 respect to municipalities, as well as with respect to counties. There are numerous studies of a variety of aspects on municipal governments, and there are a number 5 of municipalities in the State of Maryland, which have 6 been prepared in the past five or six years by the 7 Municipal Technical Advisory Service of the Bureau of 8 Governmental Research, of which Professor Burdett is the 9 head. Therein, I think, would be found a number of 10 valuable items, and I do really believe that a lot of 11 this original work would be available for your analysis 12 and study which would sufficiently provide you with a 13 basis on which you can make thorough recommendations in 14 reforming and advising changes on the present constitu-15 tional form. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: Thank you. Ridge, do you have 17
