1 mutual betting at the race tracks. I have never yet 2 received a satisfactory answer to my contention that it is inconsistent for anyone to say that it is not 3 proper to have a lottery and at the same time say that it is perfectly proper, perfectly moral, to have a pari-5 6 mutuel betting at the race tracks.

At the race tracks the state is even a

partner in this enterprise. Mr. Miles has proposed that

9 the state take over this enterprise. I think he has 10 a very good idea. I am very much in agreement with him. 11 I think that the state ought to take it over just as it

has been done in the State of New York.

13 But I do think that Mr. Miles and others 14 are inconsistent when they are in favor of the operation 15 of pari-mutuel betting, whether it be run privately in 16 partnership with the state or by the state itself, and 17 at the same time contend that it is immoral to have a 18 lettery. I might say that many people are misinformed

20 by the stand of some churches on the lottery. I happen 21 to have seen some articles in some Catholic magazines that

about the morality of the lottery. They are misinformed
