After paying off winners and covering 3 operating expenses, it has distributed \$5,255,000 among local school districts. The lottery has enabled New 5 Hampshire to increase state aid to public education 6 by more than 50 per cent." 7 Nobody has even questioned the fact that 8 this lottery has been operated on a high scale without 9 any hint of skulduggery or dishonesty. It has been 10 operated efficiently and properly and it has been 11 12 proven in New Hampshire that this can be done.
