PRESSMAN: Very well. 10 MR. SACHS: One other point, Mr. Pressman. 11 if you will. Do I understand you correctly to say 12 that the evils that were felt to be attendant upon the 13 lottery operations prior to the constitutional provision enacted in 183% I believe, were because these were 14 15 grants to private entrepreneurs so to speak and not 16 state-operated lotteries? 17 MR.
