have been studies made in the area of gambling by enough 1 committees that would establish the fact that we could 2 certainly include this in our Constitution as something 3 that is valid. I made the statement here that the greatest 5 resource in our State is the people of our state. I 6 believe anything that, of course, would have a tendency 7 to weaken or to destroy the people would not be out of 8 order as being included in our State Constitution. 9 MR. SACHS: Do you think the existing bar 10 ought to be broadened to make it clear that, for example, าา' pari-mutuel betting be abolished? 12 I certainly would favor this. MR. GRESHAM: 13 MR. SACHS: Favor broadening the provision? 14 MR. GRESHAll: Favor broadening it. Instead 15 of excluding this, I would be in favor of broadening it. 16 MR. SACHS: Thank you. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: One point you made in your 18 letter, Mr. Gresham, that interested me was the statement 19 that gambling prevents commercial growth and keeps 20 industry out of a state.
