And 2 nobody actually forces anyone to buy lottery tickets or 3 to enter in any type of gambling. When it is proposed that a lottery operated 5 by the state would cause all those hardships that are 6 spoken about, for example, those who are compulsive 7 gamblers, those compulsive gamblers will not be affected 8 one way or another as to whether/have a state-operated 9 or not because compulsive gamblers will always find the 10 means of gambling and no one in this world will be able 11

success whatsoever at any place or any area. 14 So that these people are diseased, I agree. 15 They are just as diseased as alcoholics. We found 16 that we could not prevent people from drinking by having 17 prohibition. Nor can you prevent people from gambling

to stop them. Many attempts have been made to prevent the

illegal lottery and other illegal gambling without any

by having any prohibition against gambling. This does not create the evil that he speaks 20 of. The evil is there. This will not change it in any 21
