2	MR. GOLDSTEIN: He wouldn't have to be.
3	THE CHAIRMAN: It might even be better if he
4	were a lawyer, mighta't it? You would have the Governor,
5	the Chief Fiscal man and a legal man.
6	MR. ENEY: Attorney General, for instance?
7	MR. GOLDSTEIN: Yes.
8	THE CHAIRMAN: Thinking in abstract terms.
9	MR. GOLDSTEIN: I think the fact you have
10	three people serving on the Board of Public Works, three
11	people who are responsible, have a complete knowledge
12	of what goes on in this State, who can sit there and
13	make decisions, and you have got to make big decisions
14	and make many of them.
15	MR. ENEY: That differs from the fiscal respon
16	sibility, but thinking in terms only of the fiscal respon
17	sibility for the moment, is there any reason why this

MR. GOLDSTEIN: I don't see any reason why he

can't be concentrated in one Chief Fiscal Officer, whatever name you might want to tack onto him, if he were an

elected official?

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
