several reasons already here today, unless you want to 1 2 repeat everything. 3 THE CHAIRMAN: I think he said that it makes the officer closer to the people. 4 MR. GOLDSTEIN: That is right. 5 6 THE CHAIRMAN: And more responsive to the people and hence more independent of the desires or pressures that might be brought to bear upon him, either by 8 the Governor or by legislative leaders. 10 MR. ENEY: It is that second thing that I 11. didn't think you commented on. You think he ought to 12 be just as independent of the Legislature as ne is of 13 the Governor? 14 MR. GOLDSTEIN: Absolutely, sir, an independent person elected by the people. The people scrutinize 15 everything he has done. Every four years you have an 16 election. He doesn't do the job properly. We get rid of 17 18 him. 19 MR. BROOKS: Let me pursue that with another 20 idea that has been contended and that is a post-audit 21 function perhaps should be contracted for by the General
