

1 ticket won. He became the Governor and Hall Hammond
2 became Attorney General and Mr. Lacy became the Comp-
3 troller.

4 In 1950 you had a situation where Governor
5 Lane was defeated and Hall Hammond was elected, with
6 Governor Tawes as Comptroller, and Mr. McKeldin became
7 Governor. In 1954 again you had a full Democratic ticket.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: In that primary, though, in
9 the 1950 primary --

10 MR. GOLDSTEIN: Seibert.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: No, the '50 primary, the Lane
12 ticket went in.

13 MR. GOLDSTEIN: In the primary?

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes. The ticket was Lane.

15 MR. GOLDSTEIN: Lane, Tawes and Hammond.

16 They won again.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: That is right. Tawes was not
18 opposed.

19 MR. GOLDSTEIN: He had no opposition. In '54
20 Governor Tawes still didn't have opposition.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: He still didn't have opposition
