this; but this has been done in some of the Scandinavian 1 countries. Well, that's it. 2 MR. ENEY: Dr. Michener, it seems to me there 3 is no objective or statistical test by which you can re-4 solve this question; it is purely subjective and it is a 5 matter that someone has to resolve on the basis of experience. 6 I wonder if there has been any discussion or 7 study made as to whether the experience of municipalities 8 which, as we all know, are practically universally now 9 unicameral, is applicable on the state level or whether 10 11 the municipal legislatures are of such a different character and kind that they do not furnish any guide for us here? 12 DR. MICHENER: I am not that familiar with 13 them to be able to answer your question. The argument, 14 though, that was advanced in the move to unicameral city 15 legislatures was that these were business operations from 16 which you want to exclude political considerations, and 17 the model here was the corporation and the argument was 18 made that we've got a city manager and we turn over the 19 business affairs of the city to him and this should be

conducted, as I say, parallel to a corporation.
