1 Mr. Goldstein's theory is. I don't think you are really 2 going to serve any useful purpose in questioning him along those lines, Phil, because I have known Mr. Goldstein now for 25 years, and I know that he doesn't change 5 when he has got his mind made up about something. He is not going to change it. I think we see exactly how he looks at this thing. I would think we should let it go 8 at that. MR. SAYRE: I think it conceivable, though, 10 with good history that we could have a less competent 11 Comptroller than desirable, and it would damage the 12 position of the Governor, perhaps, even though they were 1.3 on the same ticket. 14 MR. GOLDSTEIN: I think the people of Maryland, 15 the last election proved it, they will look the situation 16 over pretty good. 17 MR.
