called. I didn't mean to call Mr. Eney to defend our-1 selves but to explain to the Subcommittee what work the 2 Orphans Court of Baltimore City does. I am only talking 3 about the Orphans Court of Baltimore City, not the counties. 5 Mr. Ency very graciously said he would give us a hearing any time we wanted before this Committee. 7 I want to also make plain that the Committee consists of, I have the names. Robert Martineau, Mrs. 9 Bothe, you have the names, with all due respect to this 10 Committee in my twelve years as Judge in the Court, the 11 Committee, not to criticize the Committee, but the 12 Committee, as it stands now, have never had a lucrative 13 practice or practice in the Court. I am sure that the 14 firms of some of these young men have practice in the 15 Orphans Court. That is one of the reasons that I felt 16 slighted for not being called to be heard. 17 Now we are here, and just very briefly the 18 Orphans Court sits five days a week. The Judges are in 19 their chambers at 9:15. We leave when all the work of 20 the day is finished. I personally am there from 3 to 4 21
