testamentary problems to come in within a week or two 1 and try to do a good job. It is impossible. 2 MRS. BOTHE: Every four years you have 3 the possibility of new people. JUDGE FRIEDMAN: You can go down the 5 line, not talkin g about individuals, they don't have the practice, they didn't have the practice when they were practicing attorneys, and as judges, they never had 8 this type of law to come up to and they are just not 9 capable of jumping in within a week or month's time and 10 11 do a good job. 12 MRS. BOTHE: That brings out another point which is that every four years you run the risk of having 13 someone ascend to the Bench. I am one of the lawyers 14 15 you are talking about on this Commission that knows just about nothing. You know how rarely you see me 16 there. Yet I could decide to run for Orphans Court and 17 you would be never able to take a vacation, I am afraid. 18 JUDGE FRIEDMAN: Then I could make a living. 19 MRS. BOTHE: What I was going to ask, getting 20 21 back to this question, we, of course, are only framing a
