not a judge on the general jurisdiction level. Do you 2 think it would be possible perhaps to put some of these quasi judicial functions --JUDGE FRIEDFAN: No. I think, going to other cities and other states, I think that surrogate 5 court, probate court or Orphans Court dealing with 7 testamentary law should be a separate court. This is 8 my honest opinion. When an estate starts the court should be able to finish it completely and should have full 10 jurisdiction. I don't think it should be divided. 11 I think anything to do with guardianships, intestacy, 12 anything with a will, should be handled by the Orphans 13 Court and be completed by the court. 14 MR. HARGROVE: When you say you want it to be a separate court, would it make any difference if it 15 was a part of the court system? For example, in a 16 Municipal Court, you have a Traffic Division and Criminal 17 18 Division. The Committee in the report, I suppose, certainly you have to have a probate court, no question 19 20 about that. I don't think there is any question of 21 abolishing this court at all. I think it was just a
