matter of 'aising it. Would it make any difference if 1 this court was complete within a division of a total 2 court system? 3 JUDGE FRIEDMAN: No, I am not against that personally. I am not for rotating it. 5 MR. HARGROVE: Not for rotating judges? 6 JUDGE FRIEDMAN: That is right, because of 7 my experience, I keep on saying I because of my experience, 8 I find, I am not ashamed, I should be proud, I get calls from the judges of the Supreme Bench and they come down 10 to talk to me on these matters, not because they are not 11 good judges, they just don't meet these problems everyday. 12 What it took Judge Colgan a year and a half to learn 13 and took me twelve years to learn, I am sure the 14 judges of a higher wulrt or equal court to us are 15 not going to learn within a year or two. You give them 16 a year to rotate, next one comes in with the same 17 problem, he will run to somebody else to ask them, what 18 can I do about it? I am not saying the three judges in 19 Orphans Court now are the smartest in testamentary law 20 but I feel we do have experience and we can do a job. 21
