to have a probate division of a court of general 1 jurisdiction provided the specialized nature of the 2 probate work is recognized and the judge in that division 3 devotes his full time to that division and there is no rotation. 5 Judges. JUDGE FRIEDMAN: MR. SYKES: Judge or judges. 7 JUDGE FRIEDMAN: I will make a prediction 8 to you, Melvin, you are a good practicing attorney. 9 In Baltimore City if the Orphans Court of Baltimore 10 City has full jurisdiction and is a separate court or a 11 part of the Supreme Bench but has no rotating judges, 12 we will have more work within one year than the equity 13 court has today. 14 MR. SYKES: This may very well be. I 15 would like to get for myself and for the record an 16 answer to my question. 17 JUDGE FRIEDMAN: Don't pin me down. 18 THE CHAIRMAN: The judge has given his 19 opinion as indirectly as he can. 20 MR., SYKES: Very well. 21
