Would this be a possibility, a ten-minute 1 break, no more, and come back and we will pursue it 2 further with these two people and, somewhere close to 3 2:00, take stock as to when we will meet, as I'm sure we will have to, for a continuation sometime next week in order that we would be prepared on the items below that 6 line that I have drawn, with our recommendations at least 7 in first draft for the Commission as a whole. Would that 8 be all right? MR. ENEY: Dr. Bard, I have no idea how the 10 other members feel. You say some have 2 o'clock engage-11 ments. You might put in the alternative, as to whether 12 any of them would rather go to 2:00 and then take a break. 13 (Discussion held off the record.) 14 THE CHAIRMAN: All right, we will now move to 15 Mr. Kentner who is going to give us his own observations. 16 Most of you know Mr. Kentner has lived in Nebraska and 17 the material which you received gave you some background 18 on his work. We certainly appreciate the fact that he 19 has left his offices in Washington to spend this time 20 with us.
