(Discussion held off the record.) 1 . MR. SCANLAN: Would you say the dangers of 2 parochialism submerging a program by the only official 3 elected by an entire state are greater in the case of unicameral legislation on a nonpartisan basis, such as 5 Nebraska, than they would be in a unicameral legislature 6 that was elected on a partisan basis, or am I back to the 7 8 question you went off the record on? MR. KENTNER: Yes. 10 MR. SCANLAN: Your answer would be the same, 11 then, if we were on the record? 12 MR. KENTNER: Yes. 13 MR. MINDEL: Before we leave that: were efforts made to go back to bicameralism in Nebraska and they all 14 failed? Can you tell us what happened to those efforts? 15 There have been no serious efforts, MR. KENTNER: 16 to my knowledge, to return. These were not serious, and 17 I think in one of these reports Governor Morrison is 18 quoted as saying unicameralism would win on the ballot by 19 20 seventy-five per cent, and I think this is a fairly con-21 servative estimate.
