4 DR. WINSLOW: Or accept it.

5 MR. KENTNER: Yes.

6 MR. SCANLAN: When did Nebraska have its last
7 constitutional convention, as such, roughly?

8 MR. KENTNER: I really wouldn't know.

9 DR. WINSLOW: It's been quite a while. They
10 haven't had one recently, that I know of.

11 DR. WHEELER: I don't think in this century,
12 probably.

13 MR. KENTNER: I think it goes back to the
14 previous century, but I wouldn't --

16 cameral does not mean they are not having their problems
17 with reapportionment. Let's remember, they are having the
