MR. MINDEL: It is indicative that the people 1 of Nebraska really like it, are willing to go along with 2 it? 3 DR. WINSLOW: Or accept it. MR. KENTNER: Yes. 5 MR. SCANLAN: When did Nebraska have its last 6 constitutional convention, as such, roughly? 7 MR. KENTNER: I really wouldn't know. 8 DR. WINSLOW: It's been quite a while. They 9 haven't had one recently, that I know of. 10 DR. WHEELER: I don't think in this century, 11 probably. 12 13 MR. KENTNER: I think it goes back to the previous century, but I wouldn't --14 THE CHAIRMAN: The mere fact that it is uni-15 cameral does not mean they are not having their problems 16 with reapportionment. Let's remember, they are having the 17 reapportionment problem like us. Well, let's get to 18 Dr. Wheeler.
