very ill, there is no provision in the Constitution provided for anyone to carry on.

Governor leaves the State.

The way we carry on, I leave my -- I take my top executive assistant, and he carries on while I am absent, and Edmund C. Mester on my staff, he has the authority to carry on, but there should be someone, maybe a lieutenant governor, or someone to carry on when the

Now, I go to Europe with Dr. Elkins occasion-

ally to our overseas college, and if a very, very acute emergency arose, they would have to call me in Europe, locate me. I have to let them know where I am all the time, how they can reach me. It is difficult, it is a little bit of a trying situation when you are away for six or eight days, and you are out of the country. I mean, I think that loophole should be closed so that when the Governor leaves the State even, that there should be someone to
