1	MR. BOND: And you think there should be a
2	channel from the Governor to the department head and not
3	impeded by a board?
4	GOVERNOR TAWES: That's right. We have had
5	two or three very good examples of that.
6	MR. BOND: Yes, sir, I know.
7	GOVERNOR TAWES: In my seven years, we have
8	some examples of these people. These persons have even-
9	tually left the service.
10	JUDGE ADKINS: Passing on to right down this
11	list of prepared questions
12	GOVERNOR TAMES: All right, I would like to do
13	that if you don't mind, because I am running out of time.
14	JUDGE ADKINS: We have answered several of
15	the next ones, and there are a couple of points that we
16	do want to be sure we get your views on. Do you believe
17	that your appointments or any portion of them should be
18	subject to the advice and consent of the Senate?
19	GOVERNOR TAWES: No, I don't, I don't think
20	so. I think that is a way to close the way a governor
21	on act top officient personnel. You have politics. I
