raised. Would you like to make a comment?

DR. LOEVY: Well, from the tenor of the luncheon that Jack Jones and I had, we were concerned here with something that was raised at the last meeting, just what is meant by home rule, and I really think you need someone

as it is applied in Maryland; just what powers does home rule deny to the legislature.

He raised the point, and I agree with him, if

with legal training to look at the concept of home rule

we put in compulsory home rule without knowing just what we mean, we might get into some trouble. We may be taking powers away from the legislature that we do not want to, particularly in view of the fact that the tendency in local government has been to pass more and more functions up to the state level, I think, rather than to leave it at the local level. So, I think that is one thing that should

be looked into, and this brings up then the question of enumeration.

If there is no set legal definition of home

rule that has emerged from the pattern of court decisions, do we want to establish a definition in the Constitution
